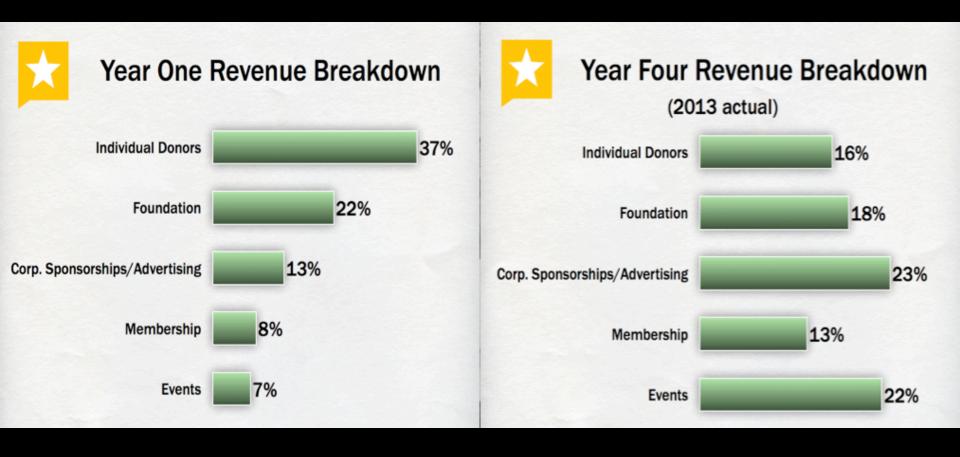




Voices from the Border: Illegal Crossings and Deportations

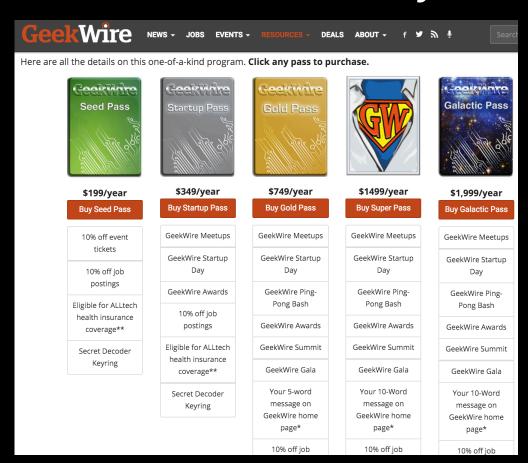
