Kim said the American leader should be considerate of whom he speaks' when making a speech in front of the world and threatened the "highest level of hard line counter measure in history".

"His remarks remind me of such words as 'political layman' and 'political heretic' which were in vogue in reference to Trump during his presidential election campaign," Kim said.

"Now that Trump has denied the existence of and insulted me and my country in front of the eyes of the world and made the most ferocious declaration of a war in history that he would destroy the DPRK, we will consider with seriousness exercising of a corresponding highest level of hard line counter measure in history."



The escalating war of words saw Boris Johnson warn the world faces a "catastrophe that it hasn't seen before" if Kim realises his nuclear ambitions.

The Foreign Secretary warned the situation in North Korea was "very, very serious."

In a Facebook video, Johnson referenced Trump mocking the North Korean leader as "rocket man."

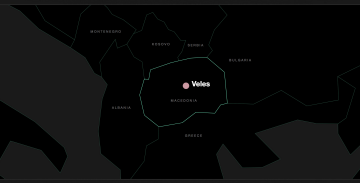
INSIDE A TOWN GEARING UP FOR 2020



Video used to make potboilers for the whole of Yugoslavia. How it makes fake news.

The sleepy seaside town in Macedonia is home to dozens of websites operated by clan and cousin networks designed to attract the attention of Americans. Each site adds cash to their bank accounts.

The scale is colossal. Over 100 websites were hacked from during the final weeks of the 2016 US election campaign, producing fake news that mostly favoured Republican candidates for President Donald Trump.

Here's a look inside the city's fake news machine as it gears up for 2020.



One of the shadowy industry pioneers is a well-spoken law school dropout. Warned that his crime accounts could be shut down, the 28-year-old decided to become only an Internet.

He bases on a different persona at night, posing the Internet as "Jessica", an American who has made a name for herself on Facebook.

The website and Facebook page that "Jessica" runs caters to conservative readers in the US.

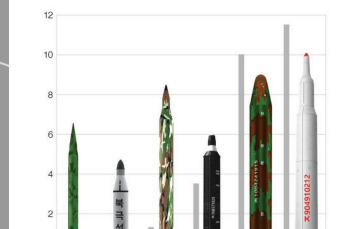



Video used to make parodies for the article of Pyongyang, how it really like there.

This essay reveals how in Myanmar is home to dozens of websites operators who churn out bogus stories designed to attract the attention of Americans. Each site adds cash to its bank account.

The scale is industrial. Over 100 websites were tracked here during the first weeks of the 2018 US election campaign, including one from that mostly ignored Republican candidate for President Donald Trump.



Here's a look inside the city's fake news machine as it gears up for 2020.

THE FAKE NEWS PRODUCER

One of the shadowy industry's players is a self-proclaimed school dropout, warned that his online accounts could be shut down, the 24-year-old asked to be interviewed as a source.
